



### Examination Notice for Students (Winter 2020 & Summer 2021)

As per the advisory issued by the State Government, Pharmacy Council of India and other regulatory agencies following are the instructions for the Winter – 2020 & Summer 2021 examinations.

1	<b><u>B. Com &amp; BCA</u></b> A. Students of Semester I, II, III and V will be promoted. B. Offline Examination will be conducted for Semester – VI. (Starting from first week of September-2021) C. Offline examination for Semester - IV will be conducted after the completion of Semester - VI examinations.
2	<b><u>B.Sc. &amp; B.A.</u></b> A. Students of Semester I, II, III and V will be promoted. B. Offline Examination will be conducted for Semester – IV & VI. (Starting from first week of September-2021)
2	<b><u>M.A., M. Com, M.Sc., MBA, MCA</u></b> A. Offline Examination will be conducted for Semester – II & IV (Starting from first week of September-2021) B. Offline examination for Semester – I & III will be conducted after the completion of examinations of even semesters.
3	<b><u>B.Sc.- B.Ed. &amp; B.A.-B.Ed.</u></b> A. Offline Examination will be conducted for Semester – II, IV, VI & VIII (Starting from first week of September-2021) B. Offline examination for Semester –I, III, V & VII will be conducted after the completion of examinations of even semesters.
4	<b><u>B. Pharm (Old &amp; New Scheme), B. Tech &amp; Diploma Engg</u></b> A. Offline Examination will be conducted for Semester – I, III, V & VII. (Starting from first week of September-2021) B. Offline examination for Semester – II, IV, VI & VIII will be conducted after the completion of examinations of odd semesters.
5	<b><u>D. Pharm:</u></b> Offline Examination will be conducted for I & II Year <b><u>PGD Yoga:</u></b> Offline Examination will be conducted for I Year (Starting from first week of September-2021)
6	<b><u>PGDCA</u></b> A. Offline Examination will be conducted for Semester – II. (Starting from first week of September-2021) B. Offline examination for Semester – I will be conducted after the completion of examinations of Semester - II.
7	<b><u>MPhLT &amp; MHA:</u></b> Students will be promoted on the basis of projects allotted to them/ field work/ dissertation report and assignments.

#### NOTE:

1. There is no provision of re-evaluation where the student has been promoted.
2. Student who is not able to appear in any offline examinations due to suffering from COVID or students who are not satisfied with the marks of promotion scheme, can apply for next cycle of examination to be conducted in conventional manner as and when applicable. Further, this will be considered as their first attempt.
3. The practical marks will be awarded on the basis of viva-voce/practical records/assignments.
4. **Duration of all the offline examinations for all courses shall be of 1.5 hours.**
5. **For B.Sc., B.A., B.Sc.- B.Ed., B.A.-B.Ed.: First & Second paper of the particular subject will be conducted in same session of 3 hours (1.5 x 2).**

7. Students failing to deposit their course fee shall not be allowed to appear/promoted in examinations.
