

## Scheme of Examination of the Ph.D. Entrance Test:

As per UGC Regulations 2016, the Ph.D. entrance test shall comprise of one written test (objective type Questions – without negative marking) followed by an interview.

The Entrance Test (written) shall be qualifying with qualifying marks as 50%. The syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of **50% of research** methodology and **50% shall be subject specific.** 

There will be objective type questions consistent with graduate level (Subject Specific) in entrance test paper. The paper will be of 2-hour duration and may be carrying 100 to 200 marks. There will be no negative marking.

The Entrance Test shall be conducted at the Maulana Azad University, Jodhpur.

For successful candidates an interview/viva-voce will be organized by the University where the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted Research Advisory Committee. Interview/viva voce shall also consider the following aspects, viz. whether:

- a. the candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research;
- b. the research work can be suitably undertaken at the Faulty/Department/Institution/College/Industry;
- c. the proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.
